Dear colleagues

We want to invite you to the first event multiplication of our project Erasmus + Key Action 2 Strategic Partnerships entitled “**Collaborative learning for enhancing practical skills for patient-focussed interventions in gait rehabilitation after orthopedic surgery**”, in short COR- skills. The project is funded by the European Commission and covers a period of 2 years starting in December 2015.

The target groups we address are: resident doctors in orthopedics and rehabilitation, physiotherapists, physiokinetherapists, managers / key personnel staff of medical education system and / or health clinics, associations related to orthopedics and medical rehabilitation, national organizations in these areas, College of Physicians.

The purpose of the event is twofold:

1) Project dissemination for direct and indirect target groups, potential users and prospective beneficiaries. So we want you as a potential interested beneficiary to be informed about the project, its aims, objectives and intellectual products that we will develop during project implementation and of which you can benefit.

Synthetically through our project we intend to develop an interdisciplinary online platform with specific learning tools and content in order to assist participants in acquiring skills in the field of rehabilitation and orthopedics. Our e-learning platform will include a guide for standard protocols in orthopedic surgery and appropriate rehabilitation procedures, along with a database of case studies. Innovation of the project refers to integration of gait analysis in the case studies as part of treatment decisions in patients with gait abnormalities.

2) At the same time the event aims to maximize the impact of transnational research conducted during the first period of project implementation by presenting the comparative results from all countries participating in the project and comparison of strategies and available resources regarding orthopedic surgical protocols and corresponding rehabilitation protocols. We also wish to inform you about new methods in gait analysis and the possibility of introducing these methods in clinical practice.
